Exclusion From and Return to School Procedures

COVID-19 Symptoms By Student Individual should be tested for COVID-19. / Faculty / Staff If test result is negative OR doctor's note with differential diagnosis, return to school after 24 hours afebrile and improved <u>Two</u> of the following symptoms: fever (measured respiratory symptoms or subjective), chills, fatigue, myalgia, headache, sore throat, congestion, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea OR 24 hours with no fever and
